- If you are executing a proxy, do not put this in the smaller envelope with your ballot.
- Put your sealed ballot envelope in the larger envelope provided (which is addressed to TES, and should have your return address) along with your proxy (if you are assigning your proxy). Seal this, apply the proper first class postage, and mail so that it is received no later than 72 hours before the election/membership meeting.
- You may make additional copies of this ballot, proxy forms, etc., as needed.
- You may also cast your ballot in person at the membership meeting; copies of this ballot will be available there.

**NOTE: Certified, Registered or Express Mail is not to be used for Election responses (ballot and/or proxy). All Election related responses must be sent by regular first class United States Postal Service mail.**
